**Crayons Needed!** With an unexpected number of requests for student school bags MMDC is in need of brand new 24-count crayons. 4,177 bags were sent to Central America and Watseka, IL. Midwest Mission is quickly running out of crayons. Please bring your donation to the office.

- **MMDC “Personal Dignity Kits” Needed!** Year after year PDKs are the #1 kit requested from MMDC and we have seen the demand double from 15, 906 in 2015 to 36,456 in 2017. In the last three years we have sent out \$1,156,960 worth of PDKs with each kit valued at \$14. PDKs are sent all over the Midwest and internationally to help people maintain basic hygiene, an essential component of human dignity. PDKs contain: bath hand towel, bath washcloth, bomb, nail/toenail clippers / adult toothbrush / shampoo/ deodorant / bar soap / razor with guard / toothpaste. All

items are placed in a one gallon plastic bag. PDKs are being shipped to Puerto Rico to help with Hurricane relief. Please bring your items to the church office.
