Scan the QR Code. You will have the option to download the app, get the app, open the app and create your account, do not include a name of who you are fundraising for so skip this step, the next screen the Church's enrollment code will be added for you, and finish your account's set-up. You are ready to begin your order.

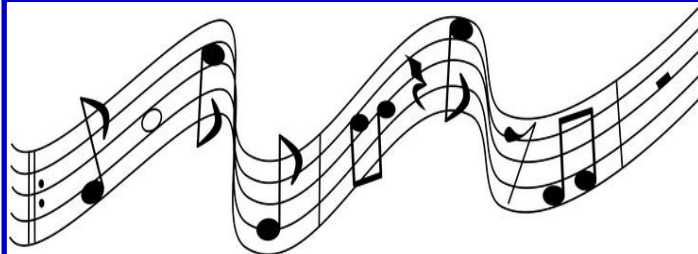

The recycle box for any size used printer cartridges is located in the coat closet by the Church Office. (On the top shelf, near the window.)

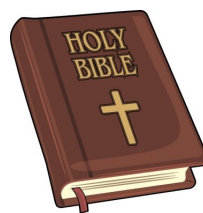

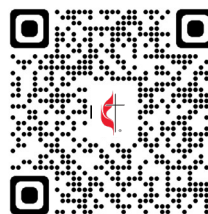
